1		<p><b>Review of Previous Minutes</b> A review of the 3 actions identified the following (i) Await advice from Grant Meredith if Shellharbour Council received notification from DoP that the annual production of CB quarry was to be increased from 400,000 ton to 600,000 ton. Action current.</p>	In progress	GM	Next meeting

2		<p><b>Current Works</b>  PL advised that blast #19 for the year was programmed for this Thursday and will be the last for the year. There has been no exceedances of vibration or overpressure. The quarry's main deliveries are currently the Port Kembla expansion works and the Leighton's Sydney Rail project. The wet weather in the recent weeks has caused delays to some productions works at the quarry.</p>			
3		<p><b>Environmental Monitoring Results</b>  HN confirmed that the 2010/2011 AEMR had been distributed in late August 2011. The conclusions were discussed as described below:</p> <p>In summary, the activities at APQ have remained within the conditions of the approval. The annual production was slightly above the target of 600,000t in 2009/2010 by 19,832t. It was also noted that the annual production in 2010/2011 was 510,137t. The annual noise monitoring achieved compliance. The dust and blasting results were within the limits. The water quality in the wells and streams were within the historical range. As predicted by Golder (water consultants), there has been a drawdown in the deep wells and no drawdown in the shallow wells</p> <p>A general discussion was held about the changes to the EPA licence as detailed in section 1.1 of the 2010/2011 AEMR.</p>			
4		<p><b>New Items</b>  No new items.</p> <p>A general agreement that as there were no issues or exceedances arising from the quarry, there were no new items that required discussion and a general agreement that the CCC was functioning well.</p>			
5		<p><b>Meeting Conclusion</b>  Meeting closed at 10:55 am.</p>
