3		<p>Review of environmental monitoring results</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2011/12 annual AEMR was released in August 2012. • No environmental exceedances in current reporting period. • Two complaints received (details tabled).EPA signoff. • Dust monitor on Western side of weighbridge was relocated due to influence of horse activity on adjoining equestrian area (EPA acknowledged). • Ecological/Environmental report. – K Mills & Assoc. was tabled and noted that the Vegetation Management Plan is being carried out effectively.SC commented that the lack of rain and cattle movements had impacted plant growth. • Erosion and Sediment Control Plan. – SC advised that the Plan had been reviewed and found to be effective. Silt ponds had been cleaned out during the dry period. Table drains and pipe drains are clear. No erosion in these areas has occurred.
