		<p>Meeting commenced at 1:05pm</p> <p>BW welcomed all members.</p> <p>BW acknowledged the traditional owners of the land and paid his respects to Elders past and present.</p>		
1		<p><b>Review of Previous Minutes</b></p> <p>Minutes from previous meeting on 13 May 2014 were accepted as accurate.</p> <p>HN advised that she had asked the Quarry Production Manager (Geoff) to provide Susan with an extra phone call to provide a smaller time slot on day of blast. SD advised this was being carried out. SD provided HN with an alternate mobile number for Geoff.</p>

2		<p><b>Current Works</b></p> <p><u>Production Report</u>            SC advised that 166,500 ton of basalt had been extracted in the year to date and 37,500 ton was extracted last month. A total of 7 blasts have been carried out this reporting year to date.</p> <p>The major customers are Cleary Bros internal, Adelaide Brighton, Fulton Hogan and Lend Lease. The quarry workload is currently slightly reduced.</p> <p>SD asked if this was likely to change. SC advised that this was largely dependant on customers' needs.</p> <p>SC also advised that the quarry would close on 19<sup>th</sup> December and return with a skeleton crew between 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> January.</p>		
3		<p><b>Environmental Monitoring Results</b></p> <p>HN confirmed that the 2013/2014 AEMR had been posted to all CCC members and is available on CB's website. A review of the Conclusions confirmed the environmental results were within objective limits.</p> <p>HN also advised that the Independent Environmental Audit was held last week and was pleased to advise that no major non compliances were identified. One minor non compliance identified that there were some weather parameters that the weather station has appeared to cease measuring which will be rectified. The audit close out meeting was scheduled to be carried out tomorrow. Once the report was received, HN advised that all CC members would receive a copy and a copy would be posted on CB website.</p> <p>SD asked if CB had conducted any blasts within 40m of her property. HN advised that CB had not to date and that a hand held measuring monitor had been used to verify this. This was the same monitor we use to measure the distance between the blast and the blast monitor to calculate the maximum instantaneous charge before each blast. HN also confirmed that CB will install a second portable blast monitor when this condition occurs.</p> <p>SD also advised that the dust monitor location appear incorrect on the map. HN confirmed that SD was correct and had notified the EPA and requested approval to vary the licence to reflect this and was awaiting a response.</p>		
4		<p><b>Other Business / Questions</b></p> <p>SD asked about increased tonnage application. AW advised DoP expect to provide a response to CB prior to Christmas.</p>
